### **STRINGS CLASS:**

Strictly Strings Book One for violin, viola, cello, bass

Old, clean, cut up pajama cloths for cleaning instruments and use as rosin rags, even old, clean baby burping cloths moms don't need any more

Big, rubber bands, the really long kind you can get at Walmart in the office supply dept. They are usually in colors, blues, pinks, etc.
