

Identified Risks of Participation

Vista School Field Trips

This is an Informed Consent Form for Minors, which identifies risks of participating in a Vista Field Trip, and a Waiver and Release for parents/guardians.

Injury may result from your participation in this program. You are expected to familiarize yourself with the program and what is required, rules of conduct for the Field Trip, as well as Vista School policies. You are expected to follow proper operating procedures including safety procedures as outlined by your teacher, and any directions given by an authorized Vista school employee or volunteer.

I acknowledge that I have familiarized myself with the program and what is required, will follow the rules of conduct, will follow the operating procedures, and will follow any directions given by an authorized school employee.

The undersigned, the legal guardian of _____ (hereinafter "student") a student at Vista School under eighteen years of age, in consideration of student's participation in a Kindergarten Field Trip do hereby agree to this waiver and release.

I recognize that participation in this trip may involve moderate to strenuous physical activity and may cause physical and or emotional distress to participants. There may also be associated health risks. I state that student is free from any known heart, respiratory, or other health problems that could prevent student from safely participating in any of the activities.

I certify that I have medical insurance or otherwise agree to be personally responsible for costs of any emergency or other medical care that student receives. I agree to release State of Utah, Vista School and their agencies, departments, officers, employees, agents, and all sponsors, officials, and staff or volunteers from the cost of any medical care that student receives as a result of participation in Vista School field trips.

I further agree to release the State of Utah, Vista School, their agencies, departments, officers, employees, agents and all sponsors, officials, and staff or volunteers from any and all liability, claims, demands, breach of warranty, negligence, actions, and causes of actions whatsoever for any loss, claim, damage, injury, illness, attorney's fees or harm of any kind or nature to me arising out of student's participation in this Charter Academy course/program. This release extends to any claim made by parents or guardians or their assigns arising from or in any way connected with the aforementioned activities.

CONSENT

In the event of injury, I expressly give my consent for any emergency aid, anesthesia and/or operation, if in the opinion of the attending physician, such treatment is necessary.

Both AM and PM classes will attend on this day.

Please have your child wear closed toed shoes.

Fri Oct 5 is Spirit Shirt and Dollar Denim Day. Students may wear a spirit shirt for free, which includes Orchestra, VRS, Student Council, Piano, etc. Students may wear jeans (which includes colored denim) for a dollar by paying a PTO volunteer at the door. **School uniform is required if student does not choose to wear spirit shirt and/or denim bottoms.**

Students will be given a snack at the Farm and lunch when they return to Vista.

Students will be supervised by teachers and staff. Volunteers are not needed for this activity. Staheli Farms has asked that parents and siblings NOT attend the Farm field trip.

If you live closer to Staheli Farms than to Vista School, you are welcome to pick up your child at Staheli Farms at 11:00am, if you have checked that box on the permission slip. If you do not check the box on the permission slip or if you do not pick up your child at Staheli Farms by 11:10am, your child will ride the bus back to Vista.
