This VCE class is for those that are curious about 3D printing, want to learn 3D design, and want to 3D print some cool stuff. Take your ideas and make them real. Will primarily be using Autodesk Inventor for design, Tinkercad and Blender may also be used. Ultimaker Cura will be used for slicing 3D printer settings. Class will include 1kg of filament to print with.

### **Beginning String Orchestra- Linda Ghidossi-DeLuca- Tuesday 3:15-4:30 \$115.00/semester Maximum Students 20**

String students who are new to playing violin, viola, cello and bass will improve their technical and musical skills by studying the solo and ensemble repertoire. Right and left hand technique exercises, scales, arpeggios, and the use of the Strictly Strings Method Book One and Two, Suzuki Book Book I and II will be included as preparation for fun classical and popular string ensemble works. Students will learn to work as a team. This class will build confidence, high self-esteem, leadership, respect, improve memory, nurture creativity, support coordination and balance, offer a bit of musical history and instruction on the care and maintenance of stringed instruments. This class is strongly recommended for students who are new to Vista and new to the strings world to assist them in keeping pace with the existing accelerated string orchestra curriculum.
